Project leader: Youth Tour Volunteer Coordinator

The Jewish Historical Society of MI conducts Youth Tours of historic Jewish Detroit. The tours are for 5-7th graders and include a few stops during which re-enactors meet the kids. This position is a wonderful opportunity for a young adult interested in theater to build his or her resume or a retired thespian who loves to work with kids. The (volunteer) job description includes:

- 1. Help identify volunteers to train and role play the characters (probably three different individuals who will be portrayed)
- 2. Help write the scripts and train the re-enactors
- 3. Work with JHSM office to schedule re-enactors for Youth Tours (approximately 4 5 times/year)

Tour docents and navigators

As word of JHSM's expertise spreads, our tours are becoming more popular than ever. We conduct several dozen bus tours a year, from large public events such as our Settlers to Citizens tours of historic Jewish Detroit to our Youth Tours and private, family tours. Docents are valued members of our volunteer team and help JHSM sustain our mission to share and celebrate Michigan's Jewish history. If you have an interest in history, enjoy speaking to groups of between 20 and 50 people, we'd love to include you in our training programs.

The (volunteer) job description includes:

- 1. Participate in a JHSM training program and ride along on as many tours as possible to become comfortable and familiar with our tours.
- 2. Once familiar with the tour content, we hope that our docents help adapt scripts and routes to suit the particular tour objectives.
- 3. Lead or co-lead at least 2 tours per year.

Jcycle - Docents

This fantastic event, now in its third year, is exploring a 14-mile area of NW Detroit. Participants are divided into groups of about 40, then ride - with group leaders - along a carefully planned route. There will be eight stops at which riders will pause and listen to JHSM docents talk about the history of that location and area. JHSM volunteers write the scripts and help train the docents.

If you are interested in the history of NW Detroit and would like to learn more, please consider being a docent for us on Sunday August 18 (morning).

The (volunteer) job description includes:

- 1. You will be assigned a location and a script in advance. We ask that you learn the script and be comfortable with it so that you are not "reading" on August 18.
- 2. You will be given an arrival time and exact details of your location. A JCycle volunteer will meet you at your stop to provide you with water and a microphone.
- 3. Once the last group comes by your location, we invite you to join us in Palmer Park for lunch.
